WELCOME TO HOTHFIELD VILLAGE HALL LOTTERY

What is it?

A monthly lottery to raise funds for the running of our village hall. The lottery is registered with Ashford Borough Council under the Gambling Act 2005

What are the prizes?

There are three prizes each month, which will total 50% of the monthly takings, "the prize fund". (First prize is 50% of the prize fund; second prize 30%; third prize 20%). So, if the annual prize fund is £2,400 (400 annual tickets sold) the first prize will be £100; second £60; third £40. However if the annual prize fund is £600 (100 annual tickets sold) the first prize will be £25; second £15; third £10.

When is the draw?

The draw will normally be held on the first Monday of the month at the Village Hall Management Committee Meeting. The first draw will be held on Saturday 02/10/2010 at the Harvest Supper.

How do I enter?

You can obtain application forms from the Hothfield Village Post Office; or by phoning Paula on 01233 628789 or Peter on 01233 623568.

It will cost £12 to join for a whole year (12 monthly draws) or £6 to join for six months (6 monthly draws).

What happens next?

When we have processed your application we will advise you of your lottery number and send you a complete set of the lottery rules for you to keep

How will I know if I have won?

The winning numbers will be posted on the notice-board in the Hall entrance, and in the Hothfield News. Additionally, we will contact each winner at the address we hold on file for them.

How much goes to the Hall?

50% of the ticket price minus admin costs, which we hope will be negligible other than the licence, will go to the upkeep of the hall. The other 50% will make up the prize fund.
